Exciting News - New Wraparound Care Provision – starting 13<sup>th</sup> January 2025

We are delighted to announce the launch of our new wraparound care provision, funded by the Department for Education as part of the government's latest initiative to support families. This service is designed to provide an engaging environment for children before and after school.

### **Opening Hours:**

- Before School: 7:30 am 8:30 am
- After School: 3:15 pm 6:00 pm

### Costs:

Breakfast Club: £4 per session

After School Care: £12 per session

Your child can still attend an extracurricular club (paid for in the same way) the cost of the afterschool care will then be reduced to £8 per session.

Child care vouchers can be accepted as payment.

### What's Included?

Children attending the Breakfast Club will enjoy a nutritious breakfast to start the day, while those in After School Care will receive a hot evening meal.

### How to Book and Pay:

Bookings and payments will be able to be made in advance through Scopay. This will be set up very soon. Bookings will need to be made by Friday of the previous week.
